We were recently told by a manager that supervising an employee with a developmental disability has equipped her with better communication skills and she has noticed that even her personal relationships have been enriched because of her improved communication style!

The Rotary Employment Partnership is a win-win initiative! It offers opportunities for a terrific investment, and a return on your values as Rotarians. Values like:

- Inclusion and improving the lives of people with developmental disabilities
