October is Disability Employment Awareness Month (DEAM)!

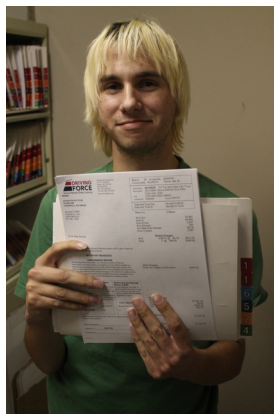
It's a month used to:

Celebrating Long Term Success

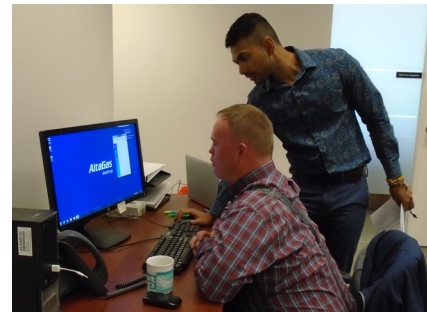
Jobs currently supported by the Partnership: 28
